

The **Environmental Services Supervisor** is responsible for managing crews in the field and ensuring that environmental projects and emergency responses are being completed. This is a hands-on position that will insure the safe and timely completion of various tasks within budget. Assignments will include both environmental and industrial cleaning projects. Examples are 24-hour emergency spill cleanup, tank and pit cleaning, pressure washing and general site cleanup. The successful candidate is expected to respond to emergency response work as required.
